


## **RECYCLE & WIN!**

This school year, the District is continuing the tradition of holding its annual Recycling Challenge to encourage schools to divert as much as possible from landfill disposal. This can be done through expanded recycling efforts and reducing the amount of waste generated in the first place! **Here's the scoop....** 

All schools that receive waste and recycling pickup through the District's contract with Republic Services are automatically entered in the Challenge.

This year's Challenge is **points based.** Schools that submit an on-line Recycling Challenge Impact Form that demonstrates their school's efforts to educate and promote recycling, waste diversion, and/or sustainability on campus will receive additional points.

## **Free Mulch!**





Schools in San Diego Unified School District can receive FREE mulch as part of the District's contract with Republic Services.

Deliveries can be made on the 1st and 3rd Thursdays of each month.

Deliveries are usually made between 11:30am-1:30pm. Request deadlines are Mondays by noon. A site contact person with a cell phone must be available to direct where to unload the material.

A minimum gate width of ten (10) feet is needed for deliveries.

Minimum order of material is ten (10) cubic yards
