CAMPUS SUSTAINABILITY

- The Custodial Team directs recycling efforts at Knox Middle. All classrooms have designated recycling bins, and ASB students help collect recyclables from classrooms, as well as cans and bottles (CRV) to raise funds.
- Lunchtime recycling education efforts focus on 6th graders, so as they move up to the next grade level they know how to actively recycle lunch trays, milk cartons, plastic bowls, and other lunchtime recyclables.
- Food left on lunch trays is dumped into a green container for composting.
- Students participate in campus clean-ups and are educated about sustainability topics, including recycling and how it helps communities, flora, fauna, water tables, and ocean ecosystems. Students also learn about solar energy by engaging with a real-time display visualizing the power harnessed from the school's rooftop solar panels.
