Marvin Elementary Campus Sustainability

- All classrooms have recycling bins with signage identifying what to recycle.
- The night custodian uses a tandem dolly with two cans. One can is gray for trash and the other is blue for recyclables. This method allows for swift collection of materials from each classroom.
- During lunch, signage directs students on what to do with trash and recyclables. Green Team students monitor milk stations, recycling stations, and stack trays.
- After educating students on how to participate in lunchtime recycling, the students know what items to place in the respective bins.

- Kitchen staff are also involved in diverting organic waste to compost activities.


